DIRECTIONS

From North/South:

Take Interstate 91 to Route 291 East. Continue on Route 291 East to exit 5A (Indian Orchard exit). Continue onto Page Blvd. Following signs for Route 20 until you reach the fourth set of lights. At the fourth set of lights, take a right onto Pasco Road. At the end of Pasco Road, turn right onto Boston Road. Boston Road Animal Hospital will be the third building on your immediate left.

From Mass. Pike East/West:

Take the Mass. Pike to exit 6, Route 291 West. Turn left traveling west on Route 291. Take the second exit (exit 5). Turn left onto Page Blvd. following signs for Route 20 until you reach the fourth set of lights. At the fourth set of lights, take a right onto Pasco Road. At the end of Pasco Road, turn right onto Boston Road. Boston Road Animal Hospital will be the third building on your immediate left.

Coming from the west side of the Connecticut River you have 5 routes across the river:

- (1) Interstate 90 (Mass. Pike) going east to I-291. Follow the directions above "From Mass. Pike East/West".
- (2) Interstate 91 going south merging with I-291. Then follow the directions above where it starts with "exit 5". (From Mass. Pike East/West)
- (3) Hwy 20 (North End Bridge) coming from Hwy 5 from the south or Riverdale Road from the north or Park Ave. off Park Street from the west. Go south on Hwy 20 to I-91 which merges onto I-291 which is also called Hwy 20.
- (4) The Memorial Bridge coming from Memorial Ave (Hwy 147) from the west or Hwy 5 from the north or south.
- (5) The South End Bridge which comes off of Hwy 57 from the east, River Road from the south or Hwy 5 from the north exiting on to I-91. Go north on I-91. Follow the directions above for "Directions from North/South".
